MEET CONDUCT: Thursday and Sunday events are timed finals. All individual events on Friday and Saturday are P/F except as noted below. 14 and under events will have A finals only (top 10). Open events will have A/B finals, except as noted below, with the A final following the B final.

- All relays are timed finals and will be swum in the prelim sessions.
- The Open 400 free & 400 IM will be scored 14 & Under and 15 & Over and will be prelims/finals with an A final only for 14 & Under and 15 & Over. Order for finals will be 14 & Under girls, 14 & Under boys, 15 & Over girls, 15 & Over boys. Prelim heats will be swum fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys

- 12 & Under 400 IM & 400 Free– timed finals swum fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys
- 800 & 1500 freestyles are timed finals, swum fastest to slowest, alternating girls and boys. 1500 free will be scored 12 & Under, 13-14, and 15 & Over. All heats of the 800 will swim during the preliminary session and will be scored 14 & Under and 15 & Over.

DISTANCE EVENTS: Swimmers entered in 800 and 1500 free should plan to provide their own timer and counter

COACHES: Coaches will be required to show current credentials in order to be on deck. Coaches MUST present their registration with valid dates on their Deck Pass App. Wristbands will be issued to those who verify current coach membership. If needed, we will hold a coaches meeting on Friday morning.

SWIMMER CHECK-IN: Check-in will be required for all events. Swimmers will circle in on the pool deck; sheets will be posted on instructional pool windows by gender and team. Circle in closes 45 minutes before the start of the session

BACKSTROKE LEDGES: Backstroke start ledges will be available for all sessions. Coaches are asked to remind swimmers of the requirement to have some part of their foot/toes touching the wall once they have placed their feet.

FLY OVER STARTS: will be used for all prelim sessions and Thursday evening.

DECK ENTRIES: will only be seeded where there are open lanes after the check-in process is completed. Individual events are \$16 and Relays \$24

TIME TRIALS: will be offered at the discretion of the Meet Referee and Meet director. Time trials may be offered at the conclusion of Saturday and Sunday morning sessions. Time trials count towards daily limitations and only swimmers who are entered in an individual event in the meet may participate in time trials. Time trials entries will close 90 minutes prior to the end of each session. Swimmers must sign up in advance at the deck entry table at a cost of \$20.00 per individual event and \$32.00 per relay

MEET WORKERS: Check-in will be required for all meet workers on deck and wrist bands will be required to have access to the deck. Those counting/timing for a swimmer for 1500 free will be permitted on the deck only to time/count We are asking that all teams try and provide a few timers. AWARDS: Should be picked up by coaches at the end of the meet

ADMISSION: \$5.00 per spectator per day 65 & Over/5 & Under are free. Please, no bills larger than \$20.00

JOLYN & NORTHWEST DESIGN: Please be sure that your swimmers and families visit our vendors located in the lobby outside the stands.

PARKING: CSU charges for event parking (est. \$10.00 per day). Parking lots are available at the corner of Chester and E. 22nd Street or on Euclid Ave and E 24th Street. City of Cleveland meter parking is available on Chester Avenue. Cleveland State University offers metered parking on a limited basis.

Only athletes entered in the meet, working coaches, officials, and working meet volunteers are allowed on deck. All others must remain in the spectator areas. Parents, Guardians, and Spectators should not plan to meet their swimmers on the pool deck or in the locker rooms before, during, or after the meet, as they will be denied access to those areas.

LESI Scratch Rule

(1) Each swimmer/relay team shall be aware of the meet starting time and shall report to the proper meet authorities promptly upon call.

(2) **Pre-Seeded Events:** Each swimmer/relay team shall report promptly to the Clerk of Course or starting blocks prior to the race in which the swimmer/relay team is entered. Any swimmer/relay team not reporting for or competing shall not be penalized. Teams that enter multiple swimmers and subsequently fail to notify the meet host prior to the seeding that multiple swimmers they entered do not intend to compete may be fined \$25 per swimmer per day, at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

(3) Events Seeded on the Deck

(a) Events seeded on the deck shall be closed for seeding no earlier than forty-five (45) minutes prior to the start of the session. Host may provide alternate methods of check-in (such as email, phone, and fax) for swimmers who do not plan to arrive before the scratch deadline.

(b) Any swimmer who has checked in for an individual event 400 yards/meters or longer must swim in the event unless the swimmer notifies the Administrative Official before the seeding of the event has begun that the swimmer wishes to scratch; failure to scratch prior to seeding and not swimming the event will result in a fine of \$25.00 to the swimmer's club or to the unattached swimmer, except as noted in "Exceptions for Failure to Compete" (below). A declared false start or deliberate delay of the meet in events 400 yards/meters or longer is not permitted and will be regarded as a failure to compete.

(c) Any agent of a team (coach, parent, swimmer, etc.) who checks in swimmers for events when those swimmers are not present at the meet may cause a fine of \$25.00 per swimmer per day to be levied against that team, at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

(d) Events seeded on the deck and swum as a timed final with one or more heats swimming with finals shall provide the swimmer the opportunity to indicate their desire to swim only during the preliminary session by indicating this desire by placing a "P" next to their name on the check-in sheet. Any swimmer failing to indicate this desire who does not compete during the finals session shall be subject to a fine of \$25.00, except as noted in "Exceptions for Failure to Compete" (below).

(4) Scratching from Finals

(a) Any swimmer qualifying for a bonus, consolation, or championship final race in an individual event who fails to compete in said final race shall be barred from their next individual preliminary event, except as noted below in "Exceptions for Failure to Compete." If such failure to compete occurs on the swimmer's last day of the meet, the swimmer's club shall be fined twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) by LESI. If the swimmer is not a member of a USA Swimming member club, the swimmer shall be fined \$25.00. A declared false start or deliberate delay of meet is not permitted and will be regarded as a failure to compete.

(b) In the event of withdrawal or barring of a swimmer from competition, the Referee shall fill the bonus, consolation, or championship final, when possible, with the next qualified swimmer(s). First and second alternates shall be announced along with the final qualifiers. These alternates shall not be penalized if unavailable to compete in the finals.

(c) When consolation finals have not yet been swum and a barring or withdrawal is known to the Referee, the Referee shall re-seed the consolation final and the final, if necessary, to insert the alternate(s) in the appropriate lane(s), filling all lanes in the final.

(d) If a consolation final has already been contested, the final shall be swum without reseeding for the empty lane(s).

(5) Exceptions for Failure to Compete: No penalty shall apply for failure to withdraw or compete in an individual event if

(a) The Referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts the proof thereof.

(b) A swimmer qualifying for a bonus or consolation final or final race following preliminaries notifies the Referee or designee within thirty (30) minutes after the announcement of the qualifiers for that race that the swimmer may not intend to compete. The swimmer must declare within thirty (30) minutes following the swimmer's last individual preliminary event a final intention to scratch or swim.

(c) It is determined by the Referee that failure to compete is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.
