**Morning session warm-ups will be split into two 30 minute sessions, starting at 7:30 am:**

**Session I : 7:30 to 8:00am - GLSS, LESD, and STRS.**

**Session II : 8:00 to 8:30am - All other teams.**

**Afternoon session warm-ups will be begin not before 12:40pm and be split into two 30 minute sessions.**

**Session I : GLSS, BEST, HSC, and LSSC.**

**Session II : All other teams.**

**Deck Entries will be taken only to fill empty lanes.** Deck entrants should sign up at the deck entry table before 8:00am in the morning session and until 35 minutes before the start of the afternoon session.

If your team has known scratches please notify the Deck Entry table before 8:00am for the morning session and before deck entries close in the afternoon session.

**Clerk of Course:** Clerk of course **will** be available in the morning session only. All 10 and under swimmers should report to the clerk of course located in the gym immediately following warm-ups.

**Spectator Seating:** The natatorium has spectator seating for 300. It will be limited to spectators only. No swim bags, coolers or swimmers will be allowed in the spectator seats. This is also a safety issue as wet swimmers will make the area slippery. Swimmers will be in the gym and on the pool deck right before their event.

**Parking: Parking is free.** There is a very small lot on the south side of the Bedford High School off Berwin Rd. by the entrance to the pool. Please reserve this lot for handicapped and meet officials. For general parking follow Berwin Rd. just past the school make a slight right turn into the parking lot. Additional parking is available north of the school in the main lot off Northfield Rd.
