

## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO 2025 POLICY & PROCEDURES APRIL 2025

Each item will be presented as already having a motion to either approve or reject according to the recommendation of the Board of Directors. All items will be presented and voted on as an ominous Block A and Block B.

The Chair will go through each proposal one by one with the respective block. Any delegate may pull the legislation by stating "pull". Each item pulled will be revisited and discussed on the floor of the House.

Any item is subject to amendment by the House of Delegates, provided the amendment is germane to the proposal.

Such amendments must be adopted by a simple majority. Subsequently, the proposal as amended shall be presented for approval.

Anyone wishing to speak to any proposal should raise his/her hand. Once recognized by the Chair, the individual should stand, state his/her name and affiliation or position, state whether speaking in favor or against the motion and briefly state the reasoning.

A motion to close debate (call the question) can be made only by someone who has been recognized by the Chair.

Such motion is not debatable and an immediate vote to close debate will be taken.

Recommendation: The Board of Directors recommends \_\_\_\_\_ **Effective Date: Immediately** 5.1 Scheduling .1 The Scheduling Technical Planning Committee shall publish a series of meets/events 10 to be conducted on certain days/weekends for the fall/winter season and for the summer 11 season. Summer meets shall be bid the preceding Fall. Fall/winter meets shall be bid the 12 preceding Spring. a "Bid Application to Host a Meet." 13 .2 The "Bid Application to Host a Meet" form shall be submitted by the deadline published by the 14 Scheduling-Technical Planning Committee Chair. 15 .3 Conflicting Bids A. Sanctioned meets generally will be given priority over approved meets. 16 B. Where there are conflicting bids for sanctioned meets, the Site Selection Committee-17 shall determine which bid will be awarded based on but not limited to the following-18 criteria: 19 (1) What is best for the swimmers in terms of meet format and facility; 20 (2) Ability and experience of the meet host in conducting competitions; 21 22 (3) Tradition of meet (all other things being equal, priority shall be given to the -bidder who conducted the competition on the same weekend in previous-23 years); and 24 (4) Geographic location. 25 C. Appeal: Any member of LESI may appeal the decision of the Site Selection Committee. 26 (1) Appeal must be made within seven (7) days of the decision of the Site-27 28 Selection Committee. (2) Appeal shall be presented to the next scheduled House of Delegates or the 29 LESI Board of Directors meeting, whichever comes first. 30 (3) A \$50.00 filing fee, payable to LESI, shall accompany each appeal. 31 (4) The filing fee shall be returned if the appeal is upheld, but forfeited if it is 32 rejected. Site Selection Committee: The Site Selection Committee shall be comprised of the Age-34 Group Vice-Chair, Senior Vice-Chair, Scheduling Committee Chair, Coach-35 Representative, Athlete Representative, plus two (2) people appointed for that meeting-36 by the General Chair whose clubs are not already represented on the Site Selection-37 Committee. In case of conflict of interest or unavailability of any of these parties, the

General Chair shall appoint a replacement.

- .4 Sanction and Surcharge Fees
  - A. Surcharge: Except as otherwise stated in these Policies & Procedures; a meet surcharge of \$3.00 per swimmer shall be levied at each sanctioned meet.
  - B. For all sanctioned meets swam in LESI where an entry fee is charged, except as otherwise specifiedbelow, the sanction fee for meet hosts who have a certified official registered to their team at the time of the meet shall be 20% of the entry income as defined by the number of splashes and scratches multiplied by the published entry fee. For all other meet hosts, the sanction fee shall be 25% of the entry income asdefined by the number of splashes and scratches multiplied by the published entry fee. the sanction fee for meet hosts shall be 1 dollar per splash and scratch.
  - C. For all meets where no entry fee is collected, there shall be a flat sanction fee of \$100.00 and no swimmer surcharge.

- .5 Approval and Surcharge Fees
  - A. Excepting YMCA meets, there shall be a meet surcharge of \$3.00 per swimmer at meets that are hosted by an LESI member club.
  - B. For all sanctioned meets swam in LESI, other than YMCA, where an entry fee is charged, the approval fee shall be 20% of the entry income as defined by the number of splashes and scratchesmultiplied by the published entry fee. the sanction fee for meet hosts shall be 1 dollar per splash and scratch.
  - C. For all meets where no entry fee is collected, there shall be a flat approval fee of \$100.00 and no swimmer surcharge.
  - D. For YMCA approved meets, a \$100 fee will be assessed upon application.

.4 Meet Hosts shall be responsible for finding their own officials for meets not on the schedule approved by the House of Delegates [Unscheduled Meets]. The number and certification levels of the officials required for the meets shall be determined by the LESI Officials Chair or designee in accordance with USA Swimming minimum requirements. Any additional official assignments to a meet must be approved by the Meet Director.

1.3 USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the Rules for Competitive Swimming of the Federation Internationale-de Natation (FINA) World Aquatics, LESI Bylaws (Bylaws) and such other rules and/or directives as may be issued by or recognized by USA Swimming and/or LESI shall govern the conduct of all competition sanctioned or approved by LESI and other activities mentioned herein.

224 6.1 LESI Event Records

.1 An event record may be achieved by any athlete member of USA Swimming or his/her nation's FINA World Aquatics-member organization who swims the time at a competition sanctioned or approved in LESI, or at any meet approved for USA Swimming observation in LESI where the swim is observed and approved for conformance to USA Swimming technical rules, provided that the swimmer is a member of USA Swimming or his/her nation's FINA World Aquatics member organization at the time of the swim.
