LOCATION: Twinsburg Fitness Center, 10084 Ravenna Road Twinsburg, OH 44087

POOL: 25 yards by 6 lanes, Colorado Timing System, scoreboard, locker rooms and balcony seating. Parking is located in front and behind the building.

STARTING TIMES: The pool will close 5 minutes prior to the start of each session.

WARM UP SCHEDULE:

Sunday morning session: 7:45am to 8:30am

Meet will start at 8:35

Sunday afternoon session: A 45-minute warm up will begin 15 minutes after the conclusion of the morning session.

An estimated afternoon warm up time will be posted on Lakeerieswimming.com by Wednesday November 7th. There will be a combined warm up for 45 minutes At the discretion of the Meet Safety Director, warm ups may be split by gender, age group or team.

* This will be the second stop in the passport series meets. Swimmers participating in this meet can pick up their passports and have them stamped at the awards table located in the Party Room.

ENTRY DEADLINE: The due date for entries, electronic or otherwise, is Monday, October 29, 2007. Hard copy, meet summary sheet and check must be received by Wednesday, October 31st 2007. The meet will be closed before the entry deadline if the sessions are estimated to be at four hours; so mail early. **Swimmers who no longer satisfy the time standard in an event may change events or withdrawal from an event or the meet and receive a full refund.** Mail entries to Carol Telljohann, 34581 Southside Park, Solon, Ohio 44139, or e-mail to telljohann@sbcglobal.net. **Telephone entries will not be accepted.** A Hy-Tek meet entry summary report (by swimmer) must accompany the entry that is submitted on disk or email. Entries will not be accepted until the following is received (by the above deadline) a check for the entry fee, a signed meet entry form and Hy-Tek summary report. All teams should submit entries on disk compatible with SDIF format

ENTRY FEES: Individual events \$3.00; Relays: \$6.00 plus a \$2.00 per swimmer LESI surcharge. There is a \$1.00/swimmer handling fee for entries not furnished in an electronic file. Please pay all teams entries with a single check, made payable to the **City of Twinsburg**.

ENTRY LIMITATIONS: Swimmers may enter up to 5 individual events exclusive of relay per day.

DECK ENTRIES: Fees will be based on \$6.00 per event and \$12.00 per relay. Deck entries will be taken on a space available basis up to 35 minutes before the start of the session and seeded at time/NT. Deck entered swimmers, new to the meet, will pay the \$2.00 surcharge and must provide proof of USA Registration.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmers must be athlete members of USA Swimming **and have met the time standard requirements.** Swimmers registered in Lake Erie must be members of the clubs

assigned to this meet. Coaches must be current coach members of USA Swimming and must display their coach membership cards on deck. Age is as of the first day of the meet, November 11th 2007. On deck USA Swimming registration will be available. (Does not include coach registration.)

QUALIFYING TIMES: Please see event listings. Swimmers must be **slower than** NAG "B" time standards. Events listed as 13 & over will be scored separately for 13-14, 15-16, and 17 & over. If the swimmer has no time, please include a time even if it is a practice time.

SLOWER THAN: These meets have times investigated after the meet if a protest is filed. Swimmers may not compete in an event in which they are faster than the listed time standard as of the meet entry deadline.

SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY: Entries for swimmers with a disability should be handled in the following manner: (1) enter the swimmer in the Hy-Tek database (or on the regular entry form); (2) list in the email accompanying the Hy-Tek entry file (or on a separate sheet of paper) the name of the swimmer, the stroke(s)/distance(s) s/he wishes to swim, the entry times, the day/session s/he wishes to swim the event(s), and the manner in which s/he prefers to be seeded (with a longer distance or with a different age group); and (3) provide any information about special accommodations needed by the swimmer. The final determination of seeding will be made by the Meet Referee after consultation with the swimmer and his/her coach.

CONDUCT: The meet will be conducted according to the rules set forth in the current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations. **Events will be contested in a 25-yard course.** All events are timed finals. Heats will be swum slowest to fastest.

SEEDING & CHECK IN: This meet will be pre-seeded, except for relays. These will be deck seeded. Relay cards must be turned in upon call in order to be seeded. In accordance with 102.1.4 events may be seeded together but scored separately. The Lake Erie scratch rule (attached) will be in effect.

CLERK OF COURSE: A clerk of course will be provided for the morning session only; this will be located in the Party Room.

AWARDS:

Individual Events: Ribbons for 1st-6th

Relay Events: Ribbons for 1st-3rd Place

Heat winners will receive an award.

ADMISSION COST: \$2.00 per adult; seniors (65 & over) and 8 & under children free. Cost of heat sheets are \$2.00

RESULTS: Final results will be posted on Lakeerieswimming.com Teams may request a backup at the conclusion of the meet.

SAFETY/WARM-UP: Lake Erie Swimming safety guidelines and warm-up procedures will be in effect at all times. Coaches must maintain contact with their swimmers during warm-up. All entry into the pool for warm-up is feet first from the starting block end of the pool. There is no diving during warm-up, except in designated sprint lanes. The final 20 minutes of a 45-minute warm-up shall be conducted as follows:

at the discretion of the Meet Referee or his/her designee.

- (a) Lane 1 push/pace from the start end of the pool (or general warm-up at the discretion of Meet Referee or his/her designee).

- (b) Lanes 2 & 5 sprint lanes for racing starts from the starting block end of the pool, one length only and exiting the pool.
- (c) Lanes 3, 4, and 6 general warm-up, no diving or racing starts. Any or all of these lanes may be converted to sprint lanes at the discretion of the Meet Referee or his/her designee.

Swimmers are to sprint one way and climb out at the far end of the pool. Swimmers may be removed from warm-up for violating safety rules.

OFFICIATING OPPORTUNITY – Anyone that is a USA Swimming certified official is welcome and encouraged to join the Lake Erie Swimming (LES) officials in officiating this meet. Please contact the meet director, Stephanie Zurca, or LES's Officials Chair, Chuck Kunsman, in advance of the meet if at all possible to let either know of your availability. The meet director's and Chuck's contact information is listed below. NOTE: Only athletes entered in the meet, working coaches, officials, and meet workers are allowed on deck. Other non-participants are expected to remain in the spectator area.

LAKE ERIE SWIMMING, INC.
INDIVIDUAL AND RELAY SCRATCH RULE

Each swimmer/relay team shall be aware of the meet starting time and shall report to the proper meet authorities promptly upon call.

- A. Pre-Seeded Meets - Each swimmer/relay team shall report promptly to the Clerk of Course prior to the race in which the swimmer/relay team is entered. Any swimmer/relay team not reporting for or competing in a timed final event or in a preliminary heat when finals are scheduled shall not be penalized.
- B. Events Seeded on the Deck –
 - (1) Events seeded on the deck shall be closed for seeding no earlier than thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the session. Host may provide alternate methods of check-in (such as email, phone, and/or fax) for swimmers who do not plan to arrive before the scratch deadline.
 - (2) Any swimmer who has checked in for an individual event 400 yards/meters or longer must swim in the event unless the swimmer notifies the Clerk of Course before the seeding of the event has begun that the swimmer wishes to scratch; failure to scratch prior to seeding and not swimming the event will result in a fine of \$25.00 to the swimmer, except as noted in "Exceptions for Failure to Compete" (below).
 - (3) Any agent of a team (coach, parent, swimmer, etc.) who checks in a swimmer for any event when that swimmer is not present at the meet may cause a fine of \$2.00 per swimmer per day to be levied against that team.
- C. Scratching from Consolation Finals and Finals
 - (1) Any swimmer qualifying for a consolation final or final race in an individual event who fails to compete in said consolation final or final race shall be barred from further competition for the remainder of the meet, except as noted below in "Exceptions for Failure to Compete." If such failure to compete occurs on the swimmer's last day of the meet, the swimmer shall be fined twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) by LESI.
 - (2) In the event of withdrawal or barring of a swimmer from competition, the Referee shall fill the consolation final or final when possible with the next qualified swimmer(s). First and second alternates shall be announced along with the final qualifiers. These alternates shall not be penalized if unavailable to compete in the finals.
 - (3) When consolation finals have not yet been swum and a barring or withdrawal is known to the Referee, the Referee shall re-seed the consolation final and the final, if necessary, to insert the alternate(s) in the appropriate lane(s), filling all lanes in the final.
 - (4) If a consolation final has already been contested, the final shall be swum without reseeding for the empty lane(s).
- D. Exceptions for Failure to Compete - No penalty shall apply for failure to withdraw or compete in an individual event if
 - (1) The Referee is notified in the event of illness or injury and accepts the proof thereof.
 - (2) A swimmer qualifying for a consolation final or final race following preliminaries notifies the Referee or designee within thirty (30) minutes after the announcement of the qualifiers for that race that the swimmer may not intend to compete. The swimmer must declare within thirty (30) minutes following his last individual preliminary event a final intention to scratch or swim.
 - (3) The Referee determines that failure to compete is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the swimmer.
 - (4) It is determined by the Referee that there were no alternates for the consolation final or final race in which the swimmer failed to compete, and that the swimmer's failure to

compete did not affect any other swimmer's ability to compete in the consolation final or final race.
