- **604.1** MEMBERS- The House of Delegates of LESI shall consist of the Group Member Representatives, the Athlete Representatives, the Coach Representatives, the Board Members designated in Section 605.1, the At-Large Board Members designated in Section 605.2, the Ex-Officio Members designated in Section 605.3, and the At-Large House Members.

 - .3 ATHLETE REPRESENTATIVES- Two (2) Athlete Representatives shall be elected, one each year for a two-year term, or until their respective successors are elected. At the time of election, the Athlete Representative must (a) be an Athlete Member in good standing; (b) be at least sixteen (16) years of age or at least a sophomore in high school; (c) be currently competing, or have competed during the three (3) immediately preceding years, in the program of swimming conducted by LESI or another LSC; and (d) have his or her place of permanent residence in the Territory and expect to reside therein throughout at least the first half of the term (other than periods of enrollment in an institution of higher education).
 - A. The election of the Athlete Representative shall be conducted annually during LESI's short course swimming championship, or other regularly scheduled meet designated by the Board of Directors. Prior to the election, the current Athlete Representatives and the Athletes Committee shall be asked to nominate one or more Athlete Members for consideration.
 - B. The balloting shall take place at a-scheduled meetings, <u>conducted by each Club Athlete</u> <u>Representative, that will accommodate and provide an opportunity to vote to all of that</u> <u>team's swimmers aged 13 or older</u>. Each club's balloting meeting must be made public to all nominees so to allow any nominees the opportunity to attend any or all balloting meetings to present their candidacy to the voting members. If a nominee cannot attend a balloting meeting they are entitled to provide the hosting Club Athlete Representative information to present on the nominee's behalf. The Athlete Representative elected shall be determined by a majority of the Athlete Members and Seasonal Athlete Members in good standing present and voting who are thirteen (13) years of age or older.

- C. <u>All Club Athlete Representatives will present the collected ballots from their clubs at a</u> <u>meeting called by the Senior Athlete Representative or the Athletes Committee, or failing</u> <u>that, at a time and in a manner designated by the Board of Directors</u>. for that <u>the</u> purpose <u>of</u> <u>tallying all individual ballots</u>. by the Senior Athlete Representative or the Athletes <u>Committee, or failing that, at a time and in a manner designated by the Board of Directors</u>. <u>The Athlete Representatives elected shall be determined by a majority of the Athlete</u> <u>Members and Seasonal Athlete Members in good standing present and voting who are</u> <u>thirteen (13) years of age or older</u>.
