The meet will be held on Saturday, January 6<sup>th</sup> 2018 at Youngstown State University. **The meet will feature prelims and finals for both High School and Middle-School aged athletes.** 

## Prelims:

High School: prelims session will be in the morning and is only for OHSAA high school athletes.

Middle School: prelims session will be in the afternoon. Middle school is defined as 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders. If your school has a middle school team sanctioned by the school, you may enter your athletes as a middle school team. Club and YMCA swimmers are also permitted to enter as a team, contingent on athletes being in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade. For example, Hathaway Brown school can enter middle school athletes, as well as GO YMCA team or Piranha Aquatics USA team. The athletes will swim for the team that is entered.

## Finals:

For High School: The top 24 in the 50 and 100 freestyle will come back to finals. The 500 free and relays the top 8 swimmers will come back and all other events the top 16 swimmers will come back for finals.

For Middle School: The top 8 in all events, including relays, will come back for finals.

# We hope that this meet provides an opportunity for your small team, independent swimmer(s), or a small portion of your swimmers that maybe don't experience a high volume of racing time to compete at the high school level.

**From the northwest (Cleveland, Toledo):** Ohio Turnpike to Exit 218. Follow I-80 East to I-680, Youngstown. Exit at 422 East and proceed to Wick Avenue exit. Turn right onto Wick Avenue. Turn right again at the first light (University Plaza). Go to Bryson Street, turn right, and enter the M-8 visitor's parking lot. Or you may stay on Wick Avenue and enter the M-1 parking deck, which is to the left, just past the pedestrian bridge.

**From the north:** Take Rt.11 south to I-80 East. Merge onto I-80 E via the exit- on the left- toward NEW YORK. Take the exit- exit number 229- toward OH-193/BELMONT AVE. Make a right on Belmont and proceed south about 1.5 miles to the light at Gypsy Lane. Make a left on Gypsy; at the fourth traffic light, make a right onto Fifth Avenue. Go about 1.6 miles on Fifth until you cross the overpass for Rt. 422. Go over the bridge and make the next left on the eastbound access road. Bear right past the YSU stadium. At the stop sign, go straight ahead to Wick Avenue and turn right on Wick. Make a right at the next light on University Plaza. Then, turn right on Bryson Street and enter the M-8 visitor's lot. Or you may stay on Wick Avenue and enter the M-1 parking deck, which is to the left, just past the pedestrian bridge.

**From the east:** Take I-80 West to Rt. 193 South, Belmont Avenue. Make a left on Belmont and proceed south about 1.5 miles to the light at Gypsy Lane. Make a left on Gypsy; at the fourth traffic light, make a right onto Fifth Avenue. Go about 1.6 miles on Fifth until you cross the overpass for Rt. 422. Go over the bridge and make the next left on the eastbound

access road. Bear right past the YSU stadium. At the stop sign, go straight ahead to Wick Avenue, and turn right onto Wick. Make a right at the next light on University Plaza. **From the south:** Take Ohio Rt.11 North to I-680 East. Then take exit 4A, Rt. 422 East. Exit the freeway at Wick Avenue and turn right on Wick. Turn right again on University Plaza. Go one block to Bryson Street, turn right, and enter the M-8 visitor's lot. Or you may stay on Wick Avenue and enter the M-1 parking deck, which is to the left, just past the pedestrian bridge.

**From the west (Akron, Columbus):** Take I-71 or I-77 North to I-76 East. Where I-80 and I-76 divide, follow I-80 until it intersects with I-680 to Youngstown. Follow I-680 to Exit 4A, Rt. 422 East. Exit the 422 freeway at Wick Avenue and turn right. Turn right again on University Plaza. Go one block to Bryson Street, turn right, and enter the M-8 visitor's lot.
