Lake Erie Swimming Reimbursement for National Meets

Reimbursement for National Meets is determined according to the following guidelines. These guidelines are found in the Lake Erie Handbook 2001 pages 34 and 35.

Section 8 REIMBURSEMENT FOR NATIONAL MEETS

8.3 Basis for Reimbursement

- .1 Coaches The base amount on which percentage for reimbursement is determined for any national meet shall be travel cost as defined in .3 below.
- .2 Athletes The base amount which percentage for reimbursement is determined shall be as follows:
 - C. National Championships and USA Swimming Disability Championships \$125.00, or travel cost plus \$50.00 whichever is greater.
- .3 Travel cost per met will be established by 1) averaging the incurred round trip airfares of all eligible candidates traveling coach class from an LESI regional airport to a meet area airport, or 2) multiplying the current allowable IRS charitable mileage rate by the round trip mileage between Cleveland and the meet city. Which mode of transportation is to be used to compute the base amount will be determined by the Board to reflect what is reasonable for the distance and time of year.
